《大学英语》一级课程

(College English Band 1)

一、 简要说明:

参照国家教育部制订的《大学英语课程教学要求》,同时根据我校教学资源、学生入学水平以及所面临的社会需求等实际情况,特制订本《大学英语教学大纲》,作为我校组织非英语专业本科、专升本学生英语教学的主要依据,用于指导本校的大学英语教学。大学英语课程教学包括听、说、读、写四个部分。

二、课程性质、地位和任务:

大学英语教学是高等教育的一个有机组成部分,大学英语课程是大学生必修的一门基础课程。大学英语教学是以英语语言知识与应用技能、学习策略和跨文化交际为主要内容,以外语教学理论为指导,并集多种教学模式和教学手段为一体的教学体系。

大学英语的教学目标是培养学生英语综合应用能力,特别是听说能力,使他们在今后工作和社会交往中能用 英语有效地进行口头和书面的信息交流,同时增强其自主学习能力、提高综合文化素养,以适应我国经济发展和 国际交流的需要。

三、教学基本要求和方法:

(一)教学基本要求

- 1. 听力能力要求: 能听懂简单的日常会话和课堂用语, 能听懂语速为每分钟 100 词左右的英语短文并理解其中心大意和要点。
- 2. 口语能力要求:在实际交际中做到语音、语调较为自然、得体和流畅;熟悉个人、家庭、日常生活、兴趣爱好、风俗习惯、职业、节日、社交礼仪等方面的话题,并能就这些话题进行简单的会话或陈述。
- 3. 写作能力要求: 掌握描述时间、地点、方位的基本表达方式; 掌握比较人、物体及事物的基本表达方式; 能使用适当的语言形式进行描述和表达观点、态度和情感等; 能根据特定目的有效地进行简单的文字表达。
- 4. 阅读能力要求: 能读懂语言难度一般的普通题材的文章, 领会掌握一些基本的阅读技巧, 掌握中心大意及 主要事实和有关细节, 阅读速度达到每分钟 60 词。在快速阅读篇幅较长、难度略低的材料时, 阅读速度达 到每分钟 80 词。
- 5. 推荐词汇量: 应领会或掌握 2300 左右单词和 500-600 个习惯用语或固定词组, 其中积极词汇为 900 左右, 并具备基本的构词法知识。

(二)教学基本方法

- 1. 授课以英语为主,汉语为辅;精讲多练,讲析与操练相结合;根据学生具体情况,适当融入各类有针对性的教学方法,如:句型操练,背诵与默写,小组讨论,角色扮演等;运用启发式教学的手段,调动学生学习积极性,激发学生思辨能力。
- 2. 课内外相结合,讲习与讨论相结合;适当增加文化内容和背景知识的介绍;适当采用有针对性的教学方法,如:限时阅读,归纳总结等。

本课程共280 学时,14 学分。一级70 学时,3.5 学分。根据我校学生的实际情况,本学期原则上完成7个单元《新视野大学英语读写教程》讲授内容,每单元5-6 学时;完成8个单元《全新版大学英语听说教程》讲授内容,每单元2-4 学时。另外4 学时安排期中考试与期末复习。学时安排可根据具体情况适当调整。

七、 考核内容与方法:

本课程的考试按教学计划的规定进行,将平时考核(30%-40%)与期末考试(60%-70%)相结合,以《大学英语教学大纲》的要求和教学内容为依据,着重考察学生语言基础和语言运用能力。主观题与客观题的比例约为4:6,课内课外内容各占一定比例。

- 2. 口语能力要求:能在学习过程中用英语交流,并能就某一主题进行讨论,能就日常话题和英语国家的人士进行交谈,能就所熟悉的话题经准备后作简短发言,表达比较清楚,语音、语调基本正确。能在交谈中使用基本的会话策略。
- 3. 阅读能力要求: 能基本读懂一般性题材的英文文章,阅读速度达到每分钟 60 词。在阅读篇幅较长、难度 略低的材料时,阅读速度达到每分钟 90 词。能基本读懂国内英文报刊,掌握中心意思,理解主要事实和有 关细节。能读懂工作、生活中常见的应用文体的材料。能在阅读中使用有效的阅读方法。
- 4. 写作能力要求: 能完成一般性写作任务,能描述个人经历、观感、情感和发生的事件等,能写常见的应用文,能就一般性话题或提纲在半小时内写出 90 词的短文,内容基本完整,用词恰当,语意连贯。能掌握基本的写作技能。
- 5. 推荐词汇量:掌握的词汇量应达到 2800 个单词和 800 个词组,其中 1000 为积极词汇。要求学生能够在认知的基础上熟练运用。
